

Information for international applicants

IfA welcomes applications from all sectors of the community, and this includes applicants who are not from the UK.

Please be aware of the following points when making your application for an English Heritage Professional Placement in Conservation:

1. If invited to interview, candidates should be aware that only reasonable interview travel expenses within the UK will be paid
2. Unfortunately we are unable to conduct telephone interviews as we do not feel it is a fair way to assess a candidate. There may be a practical element to the interview process and candidates will normally be shown around the host organisation and introduced to other members of staff
3. The English Heritage Professional Placements in Conservation scheme is funded specifically to develop the skills base of historic environment practitioners in the UK. Applicants from outside the UK will be expected to demonstrate a commitment to working within the historic environment in the UK.
4. Any job offer would be subject to the issue of the appropriate work permit. The successful applicant would need to make sure they were in possession of all the necessary visas needed to work in the UK for the full duration of the placement before the offer of a placement could be confirmed.
