	- Question of quantity vs quality	
	 to avoid just being 'noise', emphasize meaningful posts rather than posting on a schedule 	
	- But we don't want to 'forget' about posting	
	- Possible solution: have somebody as main poster	
	- But would still need others to feed in	
	- Worry about consistent tone, being represented by someone
