	<ul> <li>Networks and working groups as two other 'types', for less active or more loosely affiliated groups with less expectation to deliver to membership. Can set up these groups quicker without as much administrative work.</li> </ul>	
	- To support 'side groups' that don't necessarily involve entire group	
	- Can change group types based on capacity and letting CIfA know

	<ul> <li>ST was approached about possible in-person event with Buildings SIG in Gloucestershire. Tentatively schedule in 2026, late spring or autumn. AT suggests that events such as this should maximise opportunities arising from having diverse specialists all together, such as a discussion of interface between setting and historic landscape character.</li> </ul>	ST
	- IH recommends we take advantage of the above and similar opportunities for articles etc., especially if LSIG does The Archaeologist takeover	
	- CB - other groups are looking for collaboration opportunities, eg Diggers Forum	
	The Archaeologist takeover – KHL	
	<ul> <li>Next three dates will be a little tight to achieve, will go back to CIfA and ask for next dates</li> </ul>	
	- Working group composition: KHL, ST, BB, DA, TP, IH, JY	
	<ul> <li>Need to come up with a Theme, 350-word editorial from the LSIG. Will put together a comms programme to ask for submissions etc.</li> </ul>	
	Specialist matrix – BB	
	- From CIfA: in process of assessing which matrices are used, to determine if specialist matrices are more helpful than the general matrix.	
	- Discussion included:	
	<ul> <li>Would be useful to have a subgroup that reports to committee, rather than whole committee.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Could be hard to do for landscape because of breadth of group remit, but it was an ask for the AGM.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Questions raised: does the amount of work justify the matrix? Could we have guidelines rather than a matrix? Or informally talk to people, act as route into CIfA? Are we helping applicants or CIfA in assessing? Would another membership CIfA poll be helpful? Could we offer an informal 'route into membership', which we could use as knowledge base for later matrix?</li> </ul>
