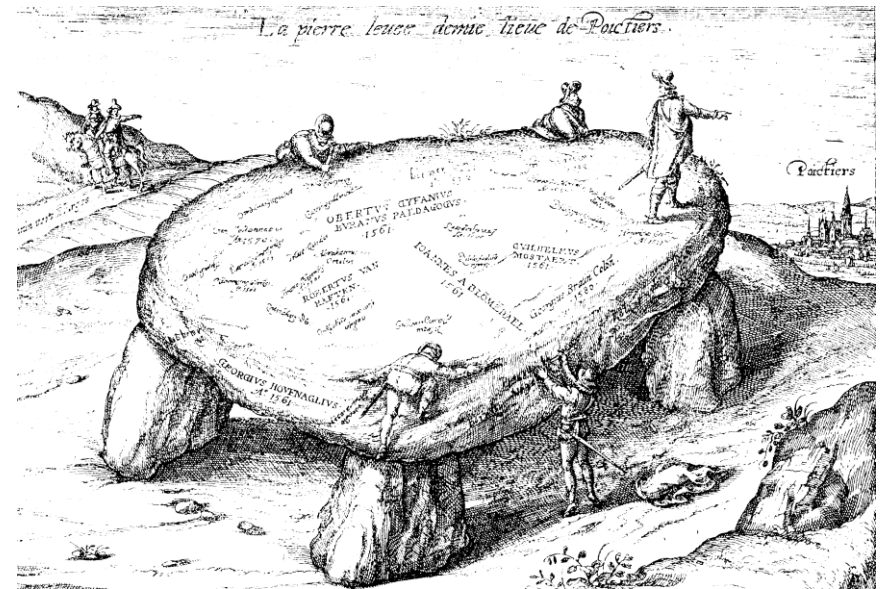

The **Neolithic Age**, Era, or **Period**, from νέος (néos, "new") and λίθος (líthos, "stone"), or **New Stone Age**, was a period in the development of human [technology](#), beginning about 10,200 BC around the Middle East (so-called *Fertile Crescent*). According to the [ASPRO chronology](#), the Neolithic starts in some parts of the Middle East, and later in other parts of the world and ending ca 2,000 BC. In Wales the Neolithic date range is between 4,000 and 1,800 BCE.
