ABSTRACT

Several projects have recently produced new guidance and resources with three Toolkits launched to support professional archaeological practice – these have focused on selecting archaeological archives, the management of digital data and specialist reporting. Presentations from Sam Paul, Louise Rayner and Amanda Forster will highlight these Toolkits helping to demonstrate how they support good practice.
